

# Hills for Everyone director recognized

Claire Schlotterbeck of Brea, executive director of Hills for Everyone, the group that founded the Chino Hills State Park, was named a woman of the year by State Senator Josh Newman in the environment category.

Ms. Schlotterbeck led the effort to create Chino Hills State Park almost 40 years ago and hasn't stopped leading the effort to protect and gain additional acres.

She leads the cooperative effort to protect open space in the Puente-Chino Hills Wildlife Corridor. Active in her own community, she helped found the Brea Senior Center and the Brea Community Center.

She also serves as board member of UCLA UniCamp, UCLA's official student charity. She received her bachelor's degree in political science from UCLA and masters from Purdue University.

She is the mother of three children and grandmother of two.


