Chino Hills State Park is located at 4721 Sapphire Road off Soquel Canyon Road and Elinvar in Chino Hills. Guests will register with staff at the front gate and drive the three miles to the Rolling M Ranch (signs will be posted). It takes about 15 minutes to get to the Ranch from the entry gate. Cell phones do NOT work in the Park.

This outdoor event is casual. Warm clothes and sturdy shoes are suggested.
