He recently retired after 35 years as an Optical Engineer and Flight Technician at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, where he worked on Galileo, Cassini, Infrared Astronomy Satellite, LDEF, Orbiting Carbon Observatory, SRTM, and many other missions.

He also has spent 36 years as the lecturer and show producer at the Mount San Antonio College planetarium. He presently is a part time operator of the 60" and 100" telescopes at Mt. Wilson.
